




Instructions on using the ArcPress extension in ArcView GIS for printing map layouts.

### Instructions


1). In ArcView activate the ArcPress Extension under FILE>EXTENSIONS (Note: if ArcPress does not appear on the list of available extensions, you will need to install the software)




2). To print with ArcPress, click the ArcPress icon on the ArcView menu bar when you have a layout or a view open.



3). Select the "Print" icon from the ArcPress dialog box.



4). Choose an available printer from the "Printer" pull down list (e.g., HP2500CM, HPLaserJet); choose HP PCL5, HP PCL3, or HP RTL from the "Device" pull down list; if necessary change "Orientation" to "Landscape", then select "OK"



5). The map will then be sent to the selected printer, check the output quality, if necessary return to step 4 and choose a different "Device" setting: HP PCL5, HP PCL3, or HP RTL and check if the output quality is improved.
